AMHA 2012 World Show Hardship Qualification Form ONE (1) horse per form.

Qualifying Show Dates: August 25, 2011 through August 27, 2012

(WS-030) In order to qualify for the AMHA World Show under Reasonable Attempt a horse/exhibitor may qualify under the following requirements. All requirements must be specifically met and documented:

1. The horse/exhibitor must exhibit in a minimum of two (2) AMHA Approved local shows under a minimum of six (6) judges. An AMHA Regional Championship Show qualifies for one (1) local show or three (3) judges.
 - a. Qualifying for the AMHA World Show is considered on a class by class basis. The horse/exhibitor must exhibit in exactly the same class in a minimum of two (2) AMHA Approved local shows under a minimum of six (6) judges to exhibit in the same class during the AMHA World Show.
2. If a horse/exhibitor wishes to exhibit in a class during the World Show which was not offered during the World Show Qualifying period, the following must be forwarded to the AMHA office.
 - a. Owners/exhibitors must provide a copy of the class list from the two (2) local shows referenced in # 2. Show location and Show date must be provided.
 - b. Indicate the class you wish to show in , but was not offered.

FORM INSTRUCTIONS

Please complete the attached form (one horse per form) with the following information:

1. Horse's full name and Registration number.
2. Horse Owner information.
3. List all AMHA approved shows needed to meet the minimum of six (6) total judges' requirement.
Show information to include: Show Name, Show Date, Number of Judges at that show, Show Manager Name (printed), and Show Manager signature.
4. List all classes desired for World Hardship Qualification. Amateur and Youth classes must also list the exhibitor name and number. Then place a checkmark under the appropriate show(s) where the horse exhibited for each class listed.

Please Note: The horse/exhibitor must exhibit in the exact same class at the AMHA approved local shows to exhibit in the same class at the World Show.

Must be received before close of entries or with World Show entries.
