SCORING:

4 Faults - Knockdowns (Lowering the height of the jump)
3 Faults - Refusals
3 Faults - Circling after crossing starting line, crossing own path, stops advancing toward or turns away from the next fence.

Front leg wraps/boots permitted. Horses can be braided
 An "in" and "out" is two jumps. (If they refuse the second fence, they can not jump the first one again;
 6-8 jumps with at least 4 obstacles
 First round - 18-32 inches (Increase 1-6 inches per round)
 Jump offs for first place only (Reserve at Championship/World Shows)
 After reaching maximum height (44") keep jumping until tie is broken.
 All ties will absorb the placing behind in order
 A course is considered set once a horse has started the course.

Eliminations

1. 3 Refusals 2. Off Course 3. Fall of horse and/or exhibitor
 4. Chain over the nose or in the mouth 5. Baiting
 6. Failure to go between the start and the finish
 cones or knocking a cone over
 7. Loss of control- drooping lead, horse running away,
 horse exciting on its own
 8. Whips are not permitted
