Nominations due by October 1st

Lifetime Achievement

Nomination to be submitted by an AMHA Member in good standing for a minimum of five years.

Nominee for the Lifetime Achievement Award must:

1. Have been an AMHA Member in good standing for a minimum of five years.
2. Demonstrated an exceptional and specific contribution or contributions toward the perpetuation, use and/or breeding of the American Miniature Horse
3. Earned documented recognition/respect as a positive, active, and inspirational representative of the American Miniature Horse breed and of the Association.
4. Clearly served to strengthen the foundation and/or to direct the vision of the American Miniature Horse breed and/or the Association.

It is important to be as specific and detailed as possible. Supportive information may include a listing of Nominee's Farm/Show accomplishments, past AMHA Board & Meeting participation, AMHA local Club accomplishments.
